



Poster and Photography Exhibit Information

There are two categories for entries:

- 1) Poster
- 2) Photograph

You may submit an entry for just one category or you may submit one entry for each category; a maximum of one entry for each category per person, will be accepted. (i.e. No double entry in the photograph category)

The Online Exhibit Contest Form must be completed online by Friday, April 6th, 2018 at 11:59pm to be accepted as an entry. In addition to submitting the entry form, the online form must be printed and attached to the back of the Poster/Photograph and submitted to the Registration Room at the Seminar on Monday, April 30th, 2018.

The Poster Exhibits:

It is recommended to exhibit your poster presentation on a trifold poster board. Individual or group posters are accepted. ***Don't forget to attach the Online Exhibit Form to the back side of the Poster.

- Forensic Practitioners can submit a poster on a new technique, research in the field, or a case review.
- Student(s) can submit a poster on a topic within any of the forensic disciplines, history, new research, etc.

The Photograph Exhibits:

You may submit either a "Forensic" or an "Art" subject photograph, but only one photograph may be submitted. The photograph can be in color or in black and white. Photo must be mounted on a board, not in a frame. The size of the photograph should be at least 8 ½" x 11". ***Don't forget to attach the Online Exhibit Form to the back side of the Photograph.



Judging:

All seminar attendees will be given a ballot and may submit one vote for each category. **Wednesday, May 2nd, 2018 at 5:00 pm is the deadline for submitting ballots.** Winners will be announced at the Installation Banquet on Thursday evening (May 3rd).
