Basic/Intermediate Diagramming with CrashZone/CrimeZone software

Note: This class will be specific to Version 10 of the FARO CrashZone/CrimeZone software. The five-day basic/intermediate course discusses the principles and operation of FARO CrashZone/Crime Zone® software used for illustrating crash and crime scenes. This in-depth, hands-on course will take you through the process of creating scale diagrams of various crash and crime scene scenarios.

Attendees will learn to draw simple to complex diagrams from scene measurements, manual data entry, and total station download files. Instruction is included for creating basic scale diagrams of either collision or crime scenes.

<u>Computers and software are not provided for our training classes.</u> Attendees are required to bring a laptop computer with the most current version of the applicable software installed (a link to download a demo version will be provided).

Topics include:

- ♦ Basics of using the drawing tools and functions
- ♦ Measuring conventions: coordinate system, baseline offset (station line), and triangulation
- ♦ Electronic file import
- Creating separate layers for illustrating multiple "views" of the same scene
- ♦ Importing and exporting images, scaling and tracing images
- ♦ Creating, modifying and placing symbols
- ♦ An introduction to three-dimensional diagramming of crash and crime scenes, and much more
- ♦ There will be one or more "field" exercises where attendees will measure a "crash scene" or "crime scene" using tape measures or handheld laser measuring devices, complete a sketch, and complete a scale diagram using the software.

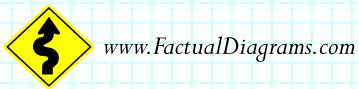
